

RYA National Hornet Association Data Protection Policy

To comply with the new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the RYA National Hornet Association has the following Data Protection Policy which clarifies what data is held by the Association and for what specific purposes:

1. Data held: This data set out in the Annual Membership form. A copy can be obtained from our website at <http://www.hornet.org.uk/>
2. Data usage/purpose: Solely to inform members of future events, such as Championships, Open meetings, receipt of class magazine, class voting and any other activity recognised by the main committee to be in the interests of the class association.
3. Data storage: No data is held any longer in hard copy (paper) format: This has all been destroyed. Data is now stored digitally and in one location. Membership lists will be provided to organisers of regattas to ensure the entrant is a member of the association and therefore can take part. After the regatta the organiser will destroy the list provided to them. Membership lists are not given to any other third parties under any circumstances.

Member's details are held for two years comprising the year of membership and the following year to enable membership to be renewed. After that the former members' details are archived on a past members database which is given the same level and security as the current members database.
4. Data removal: We appreciate that you may wish to have your data permanently removed from our storage – if you wish to have this done now or in the future, contact Association Treasurer, Peter Willans direct (07490 767314) / prwacc@aol.com.) This will be executed and confirmed when done.
