Notice of an Extraordinary General Meeting (EGM)

**An EGM will be held at
Starcross Yacht Club
Saturday 23rd September 2006 at 7pm**

**“to approve a draft amendment of existing class rules to comply
with ISAF format”**

In order to remain an RYA national class, a draft amendment to class rules, in ISAF format must be approved by an AGM or EGM of the class association and submitted to the RYA by the end of September 2006. These rules would have the same underlying message as the existing rules but in a different language/format/vocabulary. They would be implemented in the March after consultation with class members and approval of the final version by AGM e.g. March 2008 and enable us to keep our options open regarding staying as an RYA national class or not.

There is no intention to make any boat obsolete, and this would be actively avoided.

The relevant RYA minutes state: *“The Committee, in noting responses from the classes, agreed to extend the time for the adoption of new class rules, in accordance with the policy, to November 2006 provided that, in each case, the class association had tabled a draft of new rules to its AGM or EGM and that its members had indicated their firm wish to adopt the TEC policy. Should this not have occurred by the end of September 2006 then National status would be withdrawn.”*

It is planned to make the draft to be approved at the E.G.M available prior to the meeting by means of the class website, www.hornet.org.uk.

Starcross is a small village eight miles south of Exeter on the west bank of the River Exe, and the Club is situated at Powderham point approx 2 miles from Starcross village on the Exeter side. (Look for the small S.Y.C signpost marker)

Directions from the M5:

Leave the M5 at Junction 30 Exeter From the North take the third exit (From the South take the first) off the motorway roundabout (a dual carriageway) signposted Exeter and Dawlish A379.

After approx 2 miles - filter left follow A379, road then filters into rhs traffic, stay in lhs lane to Countess Weir roundabout, straight over, carry on over the 'lifting bridge' (crosses over the canal), watch for left filter lane to Dawlish A379 as you approach the large round about, filter and turn left, you will then pass under the Motorway viaduct, stay on the A379, straight over the "Swans Nest" roundabout, after approx two miles there is a slight blind left turn signposted Powderham (small SYC sign under) turn left here, carry on down this partial single track road past Powderham church and the Club is on your left, under the railway line. Caution Low Bridge!
