



Hornet Dinghy National Championships

Thursday July 21st – Sunday July 24th 2022

Welcome to the 2022 Hornet National Championships, kindly sponsored by Mcnamara Sails and Exe Sails. Weymouth Sailing Club is delighted to have the opportunity to host this event, and are looking forward provided you with an enjoyable four days of sailing a socialising.

Below you will find some information about what to expect when arriving in Weymouth, and what's on during the event.

Early Arrivals.

If you are planning to arrive earlier in the week, then please let me know and I will arrange for you to be able to access the main yard. We ask that you unload everything you need as quick as possible and then park your car in the one of the Nothe Fort car park, or if you are lucky, you may find a free space on Barracks Road on the way to the car park. This is a two minute drive from the club, and an even shorter walk back to the to the club down the steps at the end of the small car park opposite the blue food kiosk.

Arriving Thursday.

If you are arriving on Thursday morning, you will be met by a club member at the unhitch location (turn left at the Old Rooms Inn). From here we will assist you in pulling your boat by hand along the quay to the club yard. This is to prevent "traffic jams" as turning space will be limited in the club yard.





Club House Rules.

- A table service will be in operation throughout the event. Please don't go to the bar or galley hatch to order your drinks. A volunteer will come to your table.
- The club now operates a cashless service. You will be requested to pay for any food or drinks upon ordering with a card payment.
- Only alcoholic drinks purchased at the club can be consumed upstairs in the main club house.
- No wet kit upstairs in the main club house.
- Outside there are no rules!!

Registration.

Registration will be upstairs in the club house from 0900 on Thursday morning.

Food and Bar

Upon arriving ashore after sailing you will be able to have free tea, coffee and cake. This will be located in the beach master office at the top of the club slipway.

Though out the event food will be available in the evenings at the club between 1800-2000.

The bar will be open every day from 1700. If sailing is cancelled, we will do our best to try and open the bar earlier.
